MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS, HELD ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 18 2008, AT 5:00 P.M. AT LOS ALTOS CITY HALL, ONE NORTH SAN ANTONIO ROAD, LOS ALTOS, CALIFORNIA

ROLL CALL

PRESENT: Mayor Satterlee, Councilmembers Carpenter, Casas and Becker

ABSENT: Councilmember Packard (due to a conflict of interest)

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Satterlee led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. <u>Community Center Master Plan</u>

Councilmember Packard recused due to his financial interest in the real estate located at 4 Main Street, which is within 500 feet.

Council clarified that no zoning changes are required and that all the building heights are assumed to be above grade.

Motion by Mayor Satterlee, seconded by Councilmember Carpenter, to approve the following directives relative to building heights and number of stories for the three Master Plan site scenarios:

- A. One or two stories not to exceed 30 feet in height as measured above grade are acceptable, and three stories not to exceed 40 feet as measured above grade should not be ruled out given the Advisory Committee's and the City Council's desire to learn what may be gained by allowing some three story structures;
- B. Where specialty structures are required to be taller, that may deviate from the height limits, this may also be considered e.g. the fly space for rigging above the theater stage;
- C. Within reason, taller structures should be located towards San Antonio Road and further from the residential neighboring properties, where no more than two stories should be considered.

The motion carried unanimously.
