## TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS:

- 1. We, the undersigned, are the owners of land shown on the map attached as Exhibit A and made a part of this document.
- 2. We petition you to undertake special assessment proceedings for the public improvement project as described on the attached Exhibit B and made a part of this document.

#### 3. We understand:

- (a) THAT the cost of the project will be charged to the land which benefits from the project, including our land.
- (b) THAT a report will be prepared on the project including plans and specifications, a detailed cost estimate, and a division of the costs among the benefited parcels of land, and that you will conduct a public hearing on the report.
- (c) THAT we will receive a ballot that must be returned by the owners and received by the City Clerk before the conclusion of the hearing. Ballots will be counted after completion of the public hearing on the proposed assessments. Only those ballots returned will be counted.
- (d) THAT ballots will be weighted according to the respective amounts of the individual assessments. If the amount of the assessments represented by "NO" votes is greater than the amount of the assessments represented by "YES" votes, the assessment will not be levied.
- (e) THAT the cost of engineering, legal and other incidental and financing costs will be included in the project cost;
- (f) THAT each property owner may pay his assessment either in cash without interest or in installments with interest over a period of years.
- 4. The present best estimate of the total cost of the project to be financed by the proposed assessment district, including incidental and financing costs in connection therewith, is \$260,000.00 less an estimated City contribution of \$20,000.00.



# DESCRIPTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AVALON DRIVE CURB AND GUTTER ASSESSMENT DISTRICT CITY OF LOS ALTOS

- 1. The installation of concrete curbs and gutters in an existing street, including clearing, grading, subbase, base, pavement, curbs, gutters, driveways, storm drainage facilities, adjusting existing manholes and survey monuments to grade, relocating signs and mailboxes, and all other improvements and appurtenances necessary for a complete improvement of Avalon Drive between Almond Avenue and Jardin Drive.
- 2. Where necessary, the acquisition of all lands and easements, and the performance of all work auxiliary to any of the above and necessary to complete the same.
