RESOLUTION NO. 99-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS ADOPTING A PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION AND INTENTION TO ESTABLISH THE GRANT ROAD UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE AND HEARING THEREON

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the establishment of underground utilities is beneficial to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that:

- 1. Pursuant to Ordinance Number 67-12 of the City of Los Altos, this Council hereby preliminarily determines that the public necessity, health, safety, and welfare require the removal of poles and overhead wires and associated overhead structures from the public streets, alleys or ways and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service within the area designated as the Grant Road Underground Utility District as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and as proposed to be established by Ordinance to be introduced January 11, 2000.
- 2. Staff has selected the area known as Grant Road as the highest priority for undergrounding due to the unsightly and unusually heavy concentration of overhead utilities located in this area.
- 3. Tuesday, the 11th day of January, 2000 at the hour of 7:00 p.m. in the Community Meeting Chambers, City Hall, Los Altos, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where all persons interested shall be given an opportunity to be heard on the question of whether the public necessity, health, safety, or welfare require the establishment of said Grant Road Underground Utility District.
- 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of said hearing by mailing a copy of this resolution to all affected property owners and utility companies as shown on the last equalized assessment roll of the County of Santa Clara at least thirty (30) days prior thereto.
