

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-10**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NON-  
COMPETITIVE  
FUNDS FROM SANTA CLARA COUNTY UNDER THE FEDERAL HOUSING  
AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004/2005**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Los Altos has previously entered into a Joint Powers Agreement with Santa Clara County to form an Urban County under the Housing and Community Development Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held duly noticed public hearings on February 24, 2004 and March 23, 2004 on the allocation of funds under the Community Development Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the following proposals represent the community development needs in Los Altos.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that staff is hereby authorized to submit proposals for the expenditures of CDBG funds in the amount of \$166,440 as described below:

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the final 2004/2005 CDBG funding allocations are provisioned as follows:

1. That the City's CDBG program is fully funded by the Federal government; and
2. That any unspent Capital Improvement Project funding shall be returned to the City.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the County is authorized to include revisions in the Housing Rehabilitation Exhibit I, FY 2004/2005 CDBG City/Country Contract, to include the following:

The County will charge the City of Los Altos \$5,000 per project, and will not drawdown funds, unless a resident housing rehabilitation project is administered for the City. Rehabilitation administrative fees will be reimbursed from the City's Revolving Housing Rehabilitation Loan Fund. County is authorized to charge a nominal administrative processing fee on existing loans, and will be reimbursed out of the City's Revolving Housing Rehabilitation Loan fund.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute standard CDBG contracts between the City and the non-profit agencies for FY 2004/2005.
