## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR CLEAN AIR (TFCA) GRANTS FOR ALMOND AVENUE TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT AND EL MONTE AVENUE BICYCLE LANE IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the traffic calming measures on Almond Avenue near Almond School will reduce vehicle traffic speeds and increase pedestrian and bicyclist safety, thereby reducing vehicle trips and air pollution; and the bicycle lane improvements on El Monte Avenue at the intersection of Summerhill Avenue will correct a bicycle safety issue and increase bicyclist safety, thereby reducing vehicle trips and air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) has made funding available to local agencies for projects which reduce air pollution; and

WHEREAS, the BAAQMD will make the final selection of projects from a combined list of recommended projects from nine bay area counties;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Los Altos supports the application for Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) Grants for the Almond Avenue Traffic Calming Project and the El Monte Avenue Bicycle Lane Improvements.
