

**RESOLUTION 06- 02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS INITIATING ANNEXATION  
OF THE BLUE OAK LANE NEIGHBORHOOD**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Los Altos has determined that the Blue Oak Lane unincorporated urban pocket shall be annexed to Los Altos in order to better provide municipal services to the affected residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Santa Clara County Local Agency Formation Commission, which oversees and administers municipal annexations, was formed in the early 1960's to foster orderly urban growth and to encourage the incorporation of urban pockets into adjacent cities. This effort was further acknowledged when cities adopted urban growth boundaries and spheres of influence – which were meant to be cities' long term growth boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the recent enactment of SB 1266 provides municipalities a window of a opportunity to annex unincorporated urban pockets without requiring a protest vote of the affected residents in order to facilitate the correction of these boundary anomalies; and

**WHEREAS**, the subject neighborhood has been rezoned per the attached zoning and neighborhood boundary identification map and is a fully inhabited development of single-family residential homes; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Los Altos did hereby hold a duly noticed public hearing to take testimony, and does hereby move to initiate annexation of the Blue Oak Lane neighborhood;
