

RESOLUTION NO. 06-12

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS
ESTABLISHING THE CITY STANDARD FOR
PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE FOR ANNEXED COUNTY LAND**

WHEREAS, the City will from time to time proceed with annexation of unincorporated County areas within its sphere of influence; and

WHEREAS, the current City standard for streets involves performing asphalt concrete (AC) street surfacing; and

WHEREAS, unincorporated County streets consist predominately of roadways with little or no structural base that have been treated with "chip seal" and have not received AC overlays; and

WHEREAS, current City residents have generally paid for the installation of their neighborhood streets in conformance with City standards and whereby those existing residents should not have to bear the cost of bringing County roads up to City standards.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council establishes a policy that roadways that have been maintained using chip seal will continue to be paved using chip seal. Those streets that have been maintained as AC overlay streets and slurry seal streets will continue to be maintained with an AC overlay and slurry seal.
