CONFLICT OF INTEREST FILINGS ARE REQUIRED**


WHEREAS, the City has previously adopted a Conflict of Interest Code in compliance with the provisions of the Political Reform Act, Government Code § 81000, et seq. by incorporating by reference California Code of Regulations § 18730, along with attached Appendix designated Exhibit "A" in which officials and employees of the City of Los Altos are designated and disclosure categories are set forth to constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the City of Los Altos.

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered administratively suggested changes to the Appendix listing designated positions of City officials and employees along with assigned disclosure categories.



Government Code Section 87200: Applicability: This article is applicable to City Councils, Planning Commissions, City Managers, City Treasurers (Finance Directors), City Attorneys and to candidates for any of these offices at any election

CATEGORIES

Category 1

A designated employee in this category must report all investments, interests in real property owned in the City of Los Altos, income and business entities in which he or she is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or holds any position of management.

Category 2

A designated employee in this category must report all interests in real property located in the jurisdiction

*Consultants are included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to Category 1 subject to the following limitation:

The City Manager may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The City Manager's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.
