<u>Display Locations</u>: Banner poles are located at Lincoln Park, across Main Street between First and Second Streets, at the intersection of San Antonio Road & El Camino Real, and at the intersection of Grand Road & Fremont Avenue. Banners advertising the same event may be at two locations simultaneously, but <u>no event shall be advertised at both Lincoln Park and Main Street</u> <u>simultaneously or at any three locations simultaneously</u>, except when City-sponsored or by City Manager approval.

<u>Application</u>: A Banner Request Form is required for all banner reservations. The City has the right to refuse to display any banner that does not meet requirements outlined in this policy. Applications denied by the Recreation Department may be appealed to the City Manager.

Details: Regular reservations can be made up to 90 days in advance. Heritage Events can be reserves up to one year in advance. Applications and payments go to the Parks & Recreation Department, at 97 Hillview Avenue, and applicants must deliver their banner to the City of Los Altos Municipal Service Center {MSC}, at 707 Fremont Avenue. Banners must be delivered to MSC at least five business days before beginning day of display and picked up from MSC within one week of the end of display.

Advertising: No banner shall be approved for the purpose of advertising any business, service, or product.

Installation: All banners are to be installed and removed by City personnel. Any displayed without City approval will be removed.

Liability: The City is not responsible for any loss or damage to banners.

<u>Additional Information</u>: The use of vinyl paint or vinyl lettering and graphics is recommended. A 2" x 3" identification tag shall be sewn on the right side top edge of the banner. The tag shall contain the title of the banner and the sponsoring agency and must be visible when the banner is rolled or folded.

 Events using the City's banner poles must meet all of the following criteria: 1) Events must take place in the greater Los Altos area (94022/94024). 	 Eligible events sponsored by the City of Los Altos Eligible events sponsored by the Town of Los Altos Hills Eligible events co-sponsored by the above cities (held on City property and/or City pays part of the cost)
 Events must be open to all members of the public. Events must be non-sectarian, non-profit, and non-commercial. Events must be designed to accommodate over 500 individuals at any one time and in any one location (e.g., Glorious 4th, Fall Festival, Rotary Fine Art Fair, Festival of Lights Parade, etc.) 	 All other eligible events prioritized by date/time of request If two or three events pass the criteria and vie for the same schedule, allocation will be made by the City of Los Altos Parks & Recreation Department.

PLEASE NOTE:

2" snap hook carabiners MUST BE provided for each grommet hole to when the banner is dropped off at MSC for hanging.
