1. DEFINITION OF ACTION MINUTES & OTHER PROCEDURAL INFORMATION

Susan Kitchens, City Clerk provided information on action minutes and procedural information. The Commissioners received Commissioners handbooks, City Council Norms and Procedures and a handout discussing PARC Procedural/Process/Format Questions and City Clerk's Responses

2. <u>PARK HOURS ORDINANCE</u>

Beverly Tucker, Recreation Director reviewed the revised park ordinance and addressed the changes that were made and gave clarification on the hours at the tennis courts and the parks. Police Captain Tom Connelly reviewed the amended Public Park Hours section of the Municipal Code and explained the process of enforcement. COMMISSIONER LEE ENG MOVED TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO

THE MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO PARK HOURS, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BARON AND PASSED 5-1 with Commissioner Bautista dissenting.

3. <u>CHASE Proposal</u>

Beverly Tucker, Recreation Director reviewed the Youth Commission's recommendation. and introduced Leslie Lodestro from CHASE, who is looking for alternative funding for an interim renovation of a teen center. Leslie Lodestro updated the Commission on the recommendation from the Youth Commission and reiterated their selection of the Underground as a selection for a pro bono design proposal from Design Response. COMMISSIONER BARON MOVED to recommend that CHASE work with Design Response to submit a development proposal for a teen center at Underground and approve a two hundred and fifty dollar application fee to commence the project. SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CHARLTON The motion carried with a 4/2 vote. Commissioners Lee-Eng and Bautista dissenting.

4. <u>PUBLIC SCULPTURE Committee</u>

COMMISSIONER BAUTISTA MOVED to recommend appointment of Cam Chan to the Public Sculpture Committee for a regular four year term. The motion was SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER LEE-ENG AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLEY

5. WHISTLESTOP FUNDRAISING Report

PARC will present a letter to City Council stating that they have concluded their fundraising efforts

COMMISSIONER WILLIAMS MOVED to accept the letter stating that the Whistlestop Fundraising efforts have been concluded. The motion was SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BARON and passed unanimously.
