Annual Commission Training

The Annual Commission and Committee Training will be **Tuesday, April 29**th from 6:00 – 8:00 pm in the Community Meeting Chambers at City Hall. Community Center Master Plan Update

The four Commissions (PARC, Senior, Youth & Public Art) that comprised the first Community Center Master Plan Focus Group meeting created mission statements and core service statements specific to each Commission. These statements were presented verbatim to the participants at the first community workshop on April 1, 2014 as part of the orientation for the workshop activities. The next step for these four Commissions is to meet as a group to combine and refine their specific statements into one uniform mission for the entire project. This meeting will be the evening of **May 8, 2014** at the Los Altos Youth Center. The start time will be determined later this month.

Annual Egg Hunt & Egg Launch

Don't forget! Reminder from last month's staff update: This year's annual Egg Hunt for children aged walking to 10 years old is **Saturday, April 19, 2014** on the Hillview Soccer Field, near the Bus Barn Theatre. Activities begin at 9:30 am and the hunt starts at 10:00 pm sharp! In addition to the actual egg hunt, there will be arts & crafts, visits and photos with "Fun E. Bunny", a children's concert with the fabulous Okin Bloodworth and a storytelling at the main library directly afterward. The entire event is free and no registration is required. This is a very popular event that attracts over 1,000 people each year.

For children and teens who've aged out of the Egg Hunt, the Egg Launch will be held at 10:45 am on the Hillview Soccer Field, on the Hillview Avenue side. This event is also free but does require advance registration with the Recreation Department. Students are encouraged to construct creative cases that enable an egg to survive being launched into the air. The eggs are supplied by the Recreation Department and the ingenuity is supplied by the students.
