Civic Center Master Plan

The City Council identified replacing the Hillview Community Center one of its highest priorities for the 2014 calendar year on January 14, 2014.

Community Center

- Approve a Community Center redevelopment plan, including a public engagement plan
- Examine funding strategies and partnerships
- Explore connectivity to Downtown

The City Council has engaged a consultant and approved an aggressive 10 month timeline for completing a revised program for a new community center located in the general vicinity of the current Hillview Community Center. At February 11, 2014 City Council meeting, the Council will review a proposed community outreach and engagement process which includes a multi-commission focus group on the evening of February 26, 2104. The PARC is a vital component of that meeting.

Staff will provide an update to the PARC on February 12 of the February 11 City Council meeting.

Mid Year Budget Review

Another topic of interest to the PARC on the February 11 City Council meeting is the Mid Year Review of the FY2013/2104 budget. Staff will provide an update relevant budget areas following the City Council discussion.
