SUBJECT: Naturescape

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive Committee progress report

BACKGROUND

The Naturescape Committee comprised of Commissioners Tooley and Baron are preparing a proposal for a new Capital Improvement Project to create a “Naturescape” children’s play area in an existing park.

Following the Committee’s report to the PARC in March, the Commission requested that the Committee evaluate three additional City-owned parcels as potential sites and more fully develop next steps for moving the proposal forward.

DISCUSSION

The Committee completed evaluations of the three suggested City-owned parcels: the undeveloped section of Heritage Oaks Park, the vacant lot adjacent to the Woodland Library and the two corner lots of the Fremont Avenue and Grant Road intersections. The Committee also outlined more detailed next steps.
