# Tiny Tots and KinderPrep Update

The week of June 2 all three divisions of Tiny Tots Preschool and KinderPrep held graduation ceremonies. All graduates of the KinderPrep program successfully passed their entrance examinations for Kindergarten and are enrolled for the fall.

Registration for next year's KinderPrep program is currently underway. The Tiny Tots Threes and Fours program registration ended early and already have waiting lists for next year.

### Los Altos Youth Theatre Update

The summer production for Los Altos Youth Theatre (LAYT) is the Wizard of Oz, co-produced with the Los Altos Stage Company (LASC). In this first-time collaboration, LASC will provide production expertise and educational opportunities for the youth cast members including master classes in musical theatre and audition skills. Three adult theatre professionals from LASC will also perform with the youth cast.

Over forty performers are participating, divided into two casts. Rehearsals began the week of June 2. Performances for this show only have been increased to 14 from the traditional 10 due an anticipated higher demand and will run July 18 through August 3, 2014.
