Grant for Hydration Stations

The Recreation & Community Services Department has been awarded a grant from the Santa Clara County Public Health Department to purchase and install hydration stations in Los Altos Parks. The grant is through the Partnerships to Improve Community Health program and is for \$20,000. Contract negotiation for the grant funding will be in October.
