**SUBJECT**: Drinking Fountain Replacement Discussion

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Discuss options and prioritization for drinking fountains/hydration station replacement in City of Los Altos parks

## **BACKGROUND**

After receiving a report on the current status of the park drinking fountains in July, the Parks and Recreation Commission had further discussion on the subject at its regular meeting on August 12, 2015.

## **DISCUSSION**

At the August meeting the Commission agreed there are initial steps that need to be taken before creating a plan to replace the aging parks drinking fountains. The following is the list of steps that the commission agreed should be taken to initiate the process.

- Create a sub-committee
- Create a scope of work
- Create a prioritized list of the drinking fountains that need to be replaced
- Look at models of drinking fountains/hydration stations to recommend
- Determine the full cost for this project

The Commission agreed that all fountains currently in the parks should be addressed except the drinking fountains at Rosita and Village Park.
