### Halsey House Feasibility Study

Last month, staff submitted a nomination form to the Los Altos/Los Altos Hills Joint Community Volunteer Service Awards, nominating the Monkey Sock Toy Makers for their years of selfless work in the community. The Monkey Sock Toy Makers have received an award for their efforts at a luncheon on December 4<sup>th</sup> at the Crown Plaza Cabana Hotel in Palo Alto.

### Camp Shoup Thanksgiving Camp

The Los Altos Recreation & Community Services Department provided their first ever Thanksgiving camp for kids who are on break the week of Thanksgiving held at the Underground Teen Center in Shoup Park. For three days – Nov. 23-25, kids played games, baked cookies and decorated them as well as participated in craft making and various other events. The camp reached capacity with 30 participants. There will also be two additional three-day camps provided for the week of December 21 and the week of Dec 28.

### Gingerbread House Exhibit

The Recreation and Community Services Department held a Gingerbread House exhibit free of charge at the Hillview Community Center in Room 2 from November 30-December 5. Week day hours were from 8am-5pm and Saturday – Dec. 5<sup>th</sup> is from 10am-2pm. Community members provide unique and beautifully crafted gingerbread houses that are made only with food ingredients.
