## **BACKGROUND**

The Dog Park sub-committee is tasked by the Parks and Recreation Commission to look into options for a dog park, in addition to other possible dog activities in the City of Los Altos.

## **DISCUSSION**

The Dog Park Sub-committee met on Friday, January 04 at McKenzie Park to look at and discuss the possibility of recommending a fenced-in dog park at this location. The discussion was about if a dog park could work in the front portion of McKenzie Park between the tennis courts and Fremont Ave. This area currently contains benches tables and a climbing play structure and is separated from the large green space and children's play structures that are located on the other side of the City Maintenance Services yard.
