SUBJECT: Temporary sculpture placements

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive an update from the Public Arts Commission

BACKGROUND

The Public Arts Commission (PAC) is tasked with conducting sculpture searches, evaluating and selecting sculptures and identifying sculpture locations. The PAC has recommended placement of two sculptures in City parks.

DISCUSSION

Dancing Man

With the upcoming construction of the new Community Center, the City has needed to move the *Dancing Man* sculpture which was previously in font of the Hillview Community Center. The PAC has recommended that *Dancing Man* be placed temporarily at Marymeade Park on the platform behind the bench along Fremont Avenue. It is anticipated that once the community center is completed, *Dancing Man* will move from Marymeade Park.

River

As part of the recent Call for Art conducted by the PAC, the Commission has selected the sculpture *River* by artist Yoko Kubrick for placement in Lincoln Park near the Chamber of Commerce building. The location selected is generally the same location where the Doors sculpture from the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art exhibit had been placed. This sculpture will be on loan to the City for two years.
