Dear Parks and Recreation Commission,

I am writing to you to urge you to eliminate South Lincoln Park as a location to consider for a fenced-in dog park. On November 21, 2019, the Los Altos Planning Commission approved a Use permit for a 90 student school at Foothills Congregational Church, which is located directly across the street from South Lincoln Park. The traffic report estimates 230 additional daily car trips in and out of the area in relation to the new school, with drop-off and pick-up along Lincoln Avenue. The church facility has no outdoor space, so the Commission discussed using South Lincoln Park as the school's play area. Lincoln Avenue is already the main artery into and out of the Old Los Altos neighborhood. Adding a dog park to an increasingly dense neighborhood and in close proximity to a new school would create safety concerns for all.
