



### Cleaner Homes & Businesses

### 1. Advocating for cleaner electricity



- In April 2017, SVCE came on line with 100% carbon free electric power

#### **Features**

- Local control over purchases
- Local fund for energy efficiency
- Local renewable energy development
- Better pricing for solar
- Choice for our residents

### 2. Encouraging fuel-switching

- Water heating (HPWH), space heating (AS & GSHP), cooking (induction)

### 3. Promoting fossil-free new construction

- Reach Codes (~40 homes/year)
  - Takes advantage of 100% carbon free electricity
  - Safer, healthier, cost-effective
  - California is moving towards fossil-free by 2045

## **Diverting Waste at Schools**



- Worked with LAHS, Egan, Loyola, Santa Rita and Blach
- Building better systems for sorting and collecting recyclables and compostable material.







## Working with Businesses

- Offering compostables to businesses at a discount
  - Partner with Epicurean Group
  - Offer 25% discount to any organization that is interested
- Skip the Straws
  - Offer straws, table top education to address plastic pollution



## Advocating for Plastic Bag Bans



Though more than 90% of shoppers surveyed own reusable bags, a little more than 20% bring them shopping.

### 500 Trees

- Trees offered at cost, planted for FREE with help from:
  - LAHS Green Team
  - Climate Action Team
  - SLOBS, Boy Scouts,
  - Living Wisdom School
  - Together We Can, and others
- First tree planted at Rosita Park
- Total of 162 trees planted!
- Wide variety of trees
  - Valley Oaks
  - Chinese Pistache
  - Fruit Trees
  - Western Redbud

### Clean Air Advocates

### **Anti-Idling**

Working with schools and the City to reduce vehicle idling.

#### LAHS Case Study

- Surveys, signage, education
- Total idling observed reduced by 79% and 88% in the front!





#### **Gas Leaf Blowers**

Educating homeowners about the 1991 ban in Los Altos.

2- and 4-stroke engines are highly polluting and a rapidly increasing contributor to GHG inventories

1 hour of gas-powered leaf blower is equivalent to 1100 miles of driving

# **Eating Green**


Addresses animal agriculture, a critical contributor to environmental degradation:

- Generates 18% of GHGs worldwide
- Uses 29% of freshwater resources
- And 77% of all agricultural land is dedicated to animal agriculture
- Contributes to deforestation, biodiversity loss, dead zones





- We are working on educating about recipes that are simple and yummy!




