







Fenced-In Dog Park Options by Dog Ownership



Fenced-in Dog Park Preference by Address









Off-Leash Pilot Program Options by Workshop




Off-Leash Pilot Program Options by Dog Ownership



Off-Leash Hours Preference by Address






Comment Cards - Reponses

Community-driven Dog Park Input

- Commission Meeting Inspired Emails 23: 19 workshop ballots; 4 no workshop ballots of which 2 opposed to South Lincoln Park; 1 Rosita Park; 1 signage & fenced-in dog park; 8 no to Off-leash hours at Heritage Oaks Park
- Lincoln Park Neighborhood Survey Opposition to fenced-in dog park in South Lincoln Park: 111 participants/56 workshop duplications
- Community Petition Support of fenced-in dog park in South Lincoln Park: 223 participants/123 Los altos residents – no crossreferencing
- McKenzie Park Neighborhood Petition Opposition to fenced-in dog park in McKenzie Park: 48 participants/ 7 workshop duplications
- Community Questionnaire Support for off-leash hours in various parks: 84 participants/28 workshop duplications
