

# SOLICITING/PEDDLING APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The following steps are required in order obtain a permit to solicit:

- Complete the Solicitor Permit Application, then
- Submit Live Scan fingerprints using the BCIA 8016 form included in this packet. Choose a location that conducts applicant live scan fingerprinting and schedule your appointment.
- Live Scan fees are paid by the applicant. Live Scan Fingerprinting is not required for renewals. Please retain a copy of the BCIA 8016 form with the ATI# or note the date and location where live scan was completed. The live scan result time varies and will be sent directly to the Los Altos Police Department.
- Visit the Los Altos Police Department, Records Office between the hours of 8 A.M. 5 P.M, Monday to Friday and pay the Solicitor Permit fee. Bring the following items to the police department:
  - o Completed Solicitor Permit Application
  - o Copy of BCIA 8016 Live Scan form if applicable
  - o Full color recent photograph (2 inches x 2 inches) of the applicant
  - Government issued photo identification
- Once the application is approved, you will be provided documentation to present to City Hall for obtaining a business license.

# Soliciting and Peddling Ordinance Rules and Regulations

- 1) Definitions:
  - a. "Peddler" means any person going house to house or place to place selling or taking orders for immediate delivery of anything of value in the possession of the peddler.
  - b. "Solicitor" means any person going house to house or place to place selling or taking orders for goods and/or services for future delivery. (LAMC 4.24.010)
- 2) Hours:

A solicitor (permitted or not), may only solicit between the hours of 8:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday.(LAMC 4.24.070)

3) Posted Premises:

If a sign is posted (No Soliciting, Soliciting Prohibited, no Soliciting Allowed or No Solicitors Allowed) on residential premises....it is unlawful to make contact at that premises. (LAMC 4.24.080)

4) Permit Display:

You must carry, and make visible, your permit, at all times during your course of soliciting/peddling. (LAMC 4.24.090)

5) Term:

Permit is valid for 60 days only, unless revoked. (LAMC 4.24.120)

- 6) Other conditions and regulations:
  - a. Permit is not assignable or transferable...only valid for the person who purchased it.
  - b. If requested by any public safety officer or city official, solicitor/peddler is required to sign their name for comparison with signature upon permit.
  - c. If requested, solicitor/peddler is required to provide their name, business or organizations name, business address and telephone number.
  - d. If requested by customer, a receipt must be provided that plainly states the commodity or service being provided, price, total amount ordered and total amount paid or to be paid. (LAMC 4.24.130)
- 7) Permit requirements and exemptions:
  - a. Permits are required to engage in business as a solicitor or peddler and must be in compliance with the city's business license requirements.
    - i. City business license required for services.
    - ii. License is obtained through City Hall.
  - b. Permits are not required if solicitor or peddler offers for sale only goods or services with an asking price of less than ten dollars (\$10.00) per item.

I, \_\_\_\_\_\_ have read, understand, and agree to abide by the Rules and Regulation contained in the Soliciting and Peddling Ordinance. I understand that any violation of these rules and regulations can result in the suspension or revocation of the permit and may be prosecuted as a misdemeanor.



# Soliciting vs. Handbills (Residential Only)

LAMC 4.24.140 - Distribution of handbills - Excluded

Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit persons from distributing handbills door-to-door within the City without permits.

LAMC 9.08.030 - Sign prohibiting delivery of certain matter lawful

- B. No person shall deliver or attempt to deliver to any property any printed matter, advertising sample or device, where the owner or occupant has posted a sign clearly and obviously visible from an access way used by the handbill distributor which states in letters at least three-fourths of an inch in height on a contrasting background, "No Handbills," "Handbills Prohibited," or "No Handbills Allowed."
- **C.** Any printed matter, advertising sample, or device that is delivered to private property must be distributed in such a manner that it will not be blown therefrom or carried by the wind.

FAQ's

Q. Do I have to obtain a soliciting permit to leave my company information with a resident?

A. No. You only have to obtain a permit to solicit if you plan to ring the doorbell and make contact with a resident. If you wish to leave printed matter that is considered a handbill and a permit is not necessary since you are not making contact with the resident. Though you must make sure to secure the handbill so it does not become litter and blow away from the wind.

Q. If I obtain a permit to solicit can I knock on every door?

A. No. If the resident has a sign displayed on their property for "No Soliciting" you are not allowed to knock on their door.

Q. If I obtain a permit to solicit what hours are allowable?

A. The allowable hours to solicit are 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. It is unlawful for any peddler or solicitor, whether permitted or not, to enter upon any residential premises between the hours of 5:30 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
