SUBJECT: Installation of public art

RECOMMENDATION:

Discuss opportunities for the installation of public art within the City

BACKGROUND

One of the primary roles of the Public Arts Commission (PAC) is to promote the installation of public art within the City of Los Altos.

DISCUSSION

A number of potential public art installations have been discussed or mentioned as possibilities, including sculptures and sidewalk art. On November 25, 2014, the PAC submitted a recommendation, which was approved, to the City Council for the installation of two new sculptures: Jazzy at 127 First Street and Dancing Moon Rollers at Los Altos Avenue and West Edith Avenue. On December 11, 2014, the PAC recommended installation of two series of sculptures, one by Pokey Park in front of 160 First Street and the other by Jane Reyes in Redwood Grove near the current installation. The recommendation to install sculptures in Redwood Grove as well as Magic Garden in Village Park went to the Parks and Recreation Commission on January 14, 2015.
