BACKGROUND

The Public Arts Commission (PAC) recently requested submissions for the Los Altos Bike Rack Design Competition. Submissions were due to the City on November 23, 2015. The City received 73 entries which were displayed at the Main Library. Members of the public submitted their choices for designs to be installed in Los Altos.


DISCUSSION

- 7. 'Birds of Color' by Los Altos Art Docents


The entries listed are attached.

SCALE 1/4": 12" SCANNED PENCIL SKETCH 39" HEIGHT X 60" LENGTH JUDI PARRISH




@LosAltos

The "@" symbol today is iconic for things related to modern electronic communication. As an art form, the @ symbol was inducted into the Museum of Modern Art in their permanent collection. It communicated "elegance, economy, intellectual transparency, and a sense of the possible future directions that are embedded in the arts of our time."

For these reasons, the @ symbol seemed appropriate use for the bike rack competition merging art and the technological roots of many bay area tech entrepraneurs.

Specifications:

- Two bicycle rack using both sides.
- Size: 40"l x 2.5"w x 40"h
- 2 1/2" square steel tubing. Weld at joints (or fabricator recommendations)
- Stainless finish
- Underground mount.





Ice-Cream O licious!

- Underground mount
