BACKGROUND

The Public Arts Commission (PAC) recently requested submissions for the Los Altos Bike Rack Design Competition. Submissions were due to the City on November 21, 2016. The City received 33 entries which were displayed on the City's website and throughout the City.

- 'Ballet Barre' by Jena Alsup


The four chosen entries are attached.


