- 'Welcome to Los Altos' by Talia Bodner

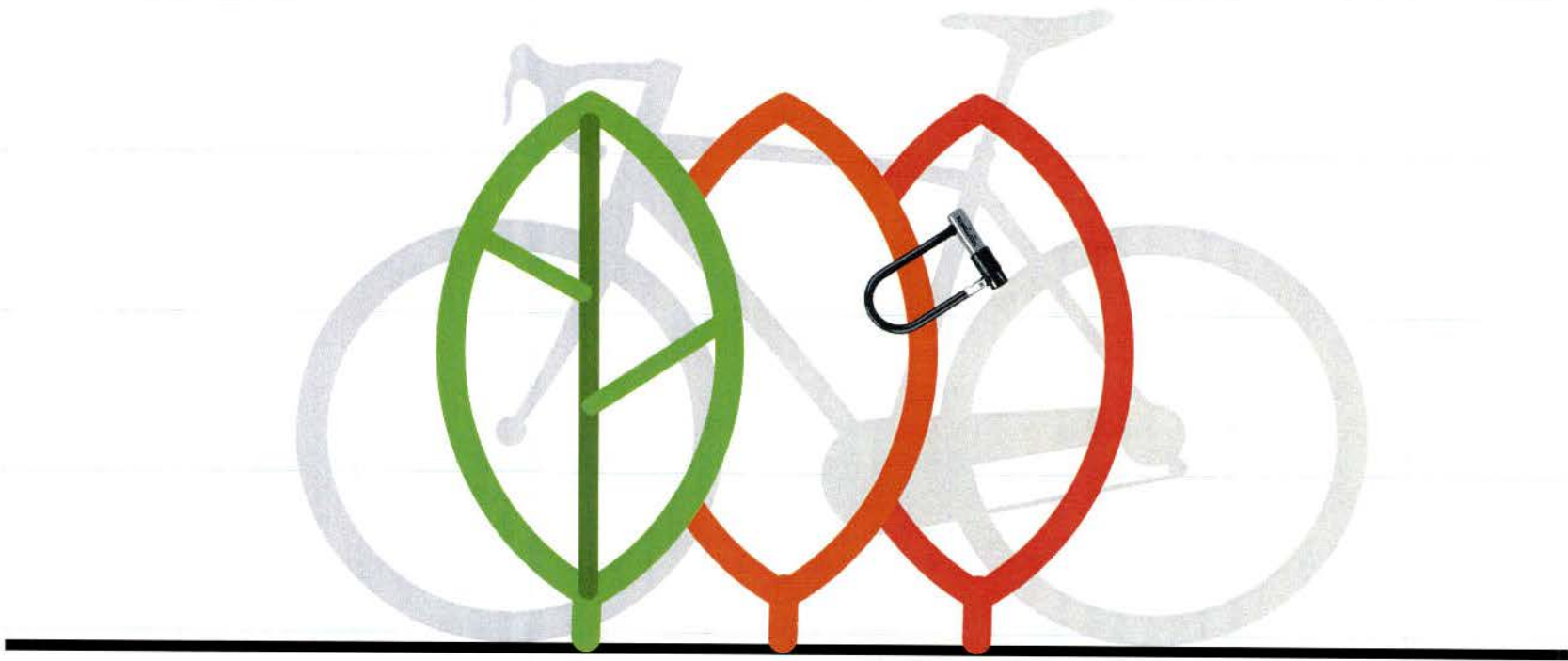

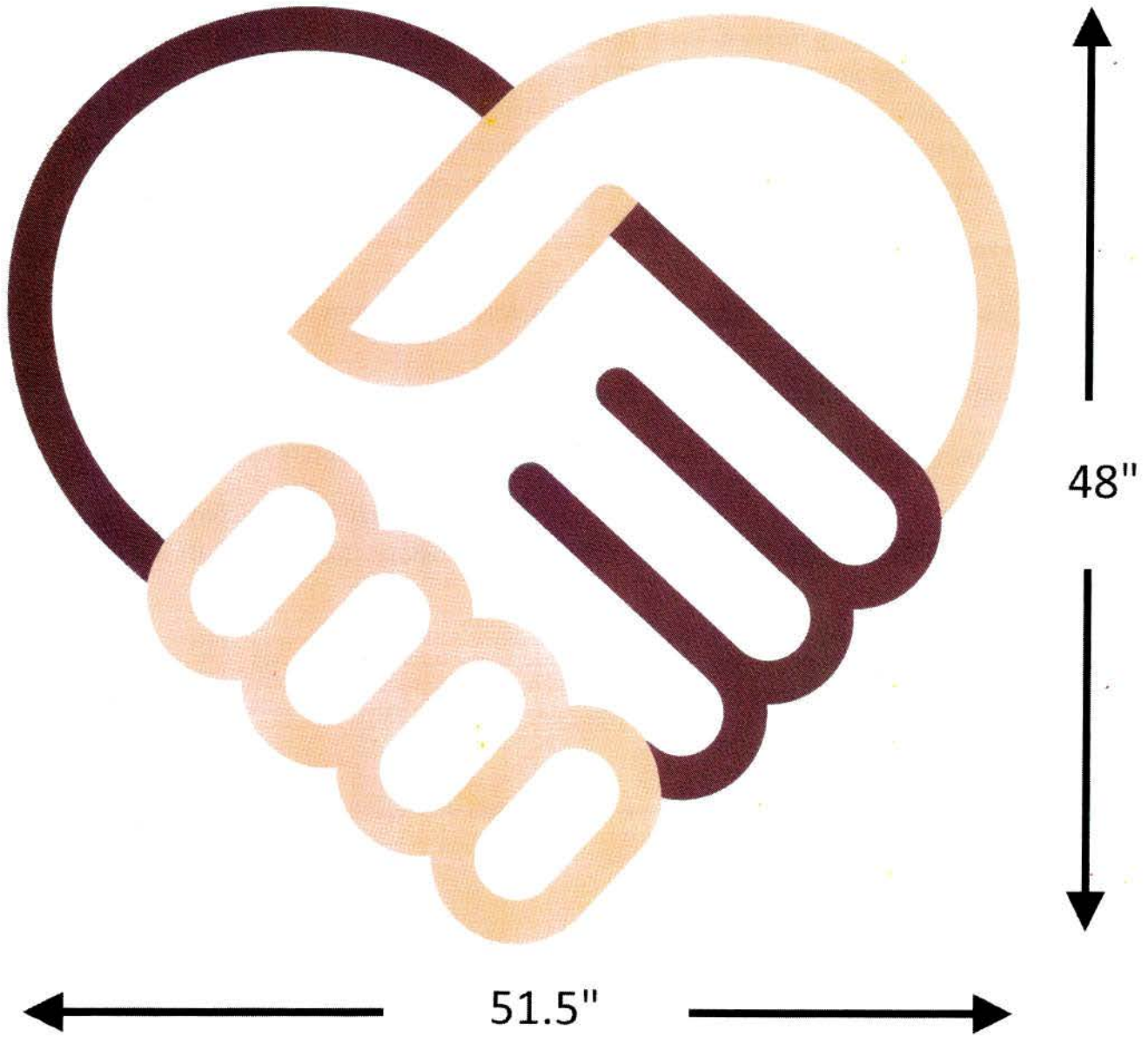

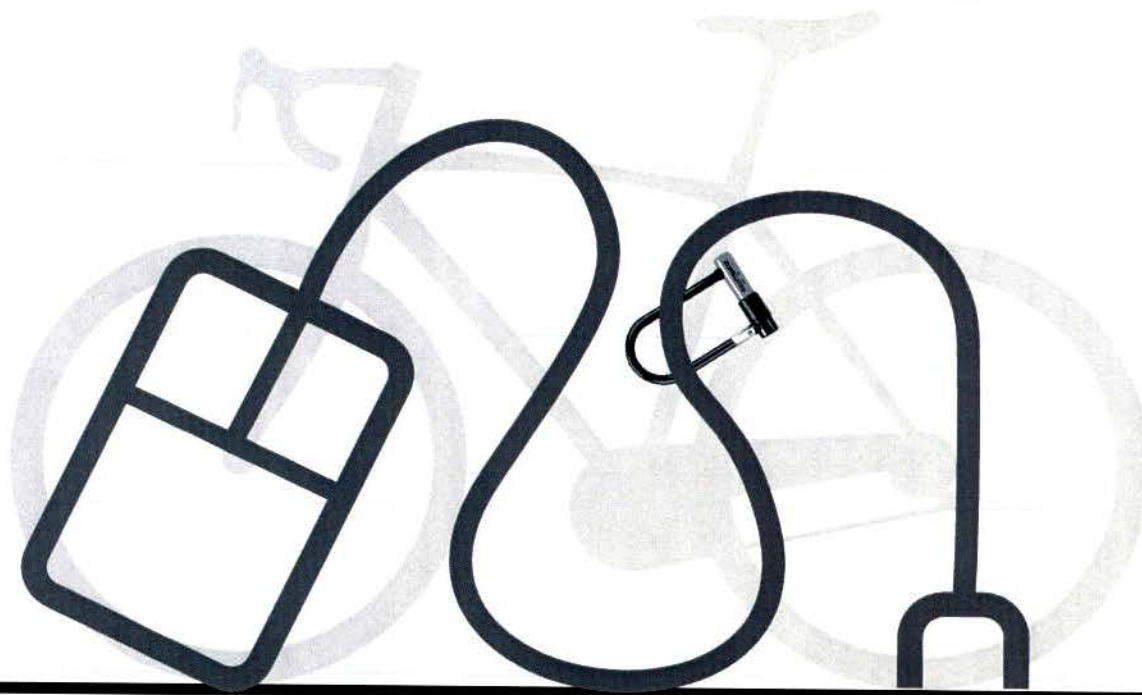


# 33 Mouse

The paperclip's angle can be adjusted to gain or lose width if needed to better fit a space. Note that the left side pipes need to be welded together to keep a closed loop for locking.

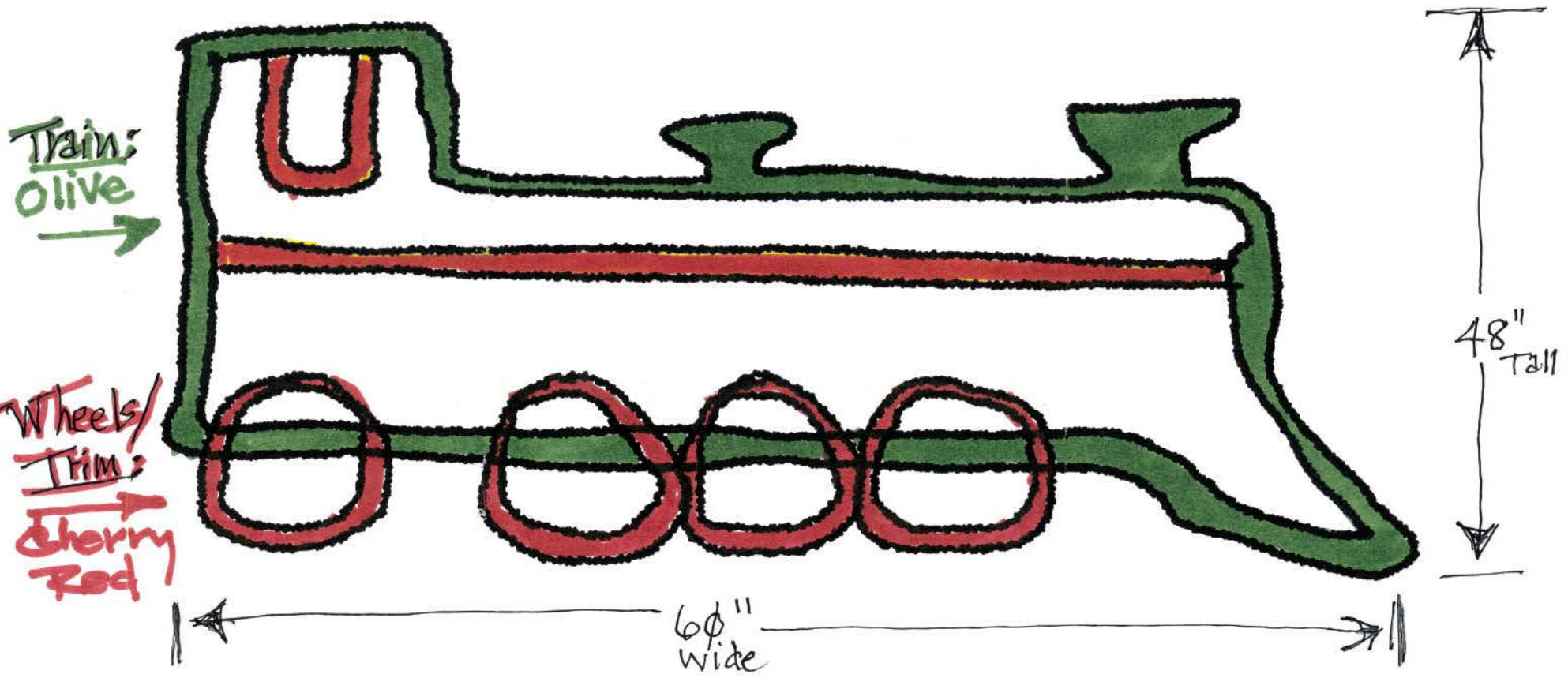
