Members of the public submitted their choices for designs to be installed in Los Altos online and at the locations where the racks were displayed. The most popular racks voted for online were:



- 'Welcome to Los Altos' by Talia Bodner










Note the mail box can be widened if a longer width is desired.














Note the scissors can be closed a bit to narrow the rack if needed to fit a space. If you need a narrower image just let me know.


