


• High visibility crosswalks at all locations

 New "Keep Clear" marking on eastbound lane of Fremont Avenue and Truman Avenue intersection



3A.ii. Bike Lane Improvements Fremont Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation Project

- Improve visibility of cyclists
- Separation between bikes and vehicles
- Green striping at select locations
- Add conflict zone striping on westbound
 Fremont Ave near Grant Road



3A.iii. Pedestrian Improvements Fremont Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation Project

• Install pedestrian crossing sign on median light pole at Austin Avenue

• Ensure pedestrian crossing signs are visible at Austin Avenue, Julie Lane, and Truman Avenue (tree trimming)



3B. Comments for Outside Coordination Fremont Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation Project

- Coordinate with <u>City of Sunnyvale</u> to improve signal phasing at Belleville Way
 - Response: We have alerted City of Sunnyvale to the issues with signal phasing at this location.
- Coordinate with <u>LASD</u> and <u>MVSD</u> for school crossings
 - Response: City is conducting safe routes to school assessments for 2020-2021.
- Coordinate with <u>VTA</u> for trail along Stevens Creek
 - Response: We contacted VTA Bike Coordinator and requested meeting.


