## **Cardboard Hideout**

(Kinder Prep 2020)



## **Supplies:**

- Cardboard (note: extra large, flat pieces can be found at Costco . . . just ask!)
- Serrated knife or exacto knife
- Markers, crayons, paint
- Painters tape



## How to:

- Sketch your design...is it a house? A castle? A boat?
- Cut out your design. Leave one edge uncut on a door, hatch, or window so it can swing open. (Tip: a pointy, serrated knife works well and you can cut out your design while holding the cardboard vertically rather than laying it on the ground).
- 3. Use painters tape to attach the sides of your cardboard to a door opening.
- 4. Have fun!

## More ideas:

- Use chalkboard spray paint to cover your piece after you've cut it out. Use chalk to decorate it.
- Push hanging clothes aside and tape the piece to the inside of an open closet door . . . it's now a secret hideout.
- Tape sides to your structure so it's free standing (see castle picture).
- Duct tape fabric to the top of windows (on the inside).
