## Rules & Information

- Deadline to enter a Gingerbread Creation is **Monday, November 30 by 5pm.**
- All ingredients must be edible, including items used in a non-edible form such as dried pasta or beans.
- Sample structural ingredients include gingerbread, cookies, crackers, candies, or other edible materials.
- Tape, glue, or pins are prohibited.
- All entries must be original work, must not violate or infringe another's rights such as privacy, publicity, and intellectual property rights, and may not include content which is offensive, violent, derogatory, sexually suggestive, obscene, defamatory, contain explicit language or imagery, or is otherwise unlawful or inappropriate for display. The entry must not promote bigotry, racism, hatred, or harm against any group or individual or promote discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age. All decisions regarding appropriateness of an entry are at the sole discretion of the City of Los Altos.
