DISCUSSION



For the past six weeks a group of 32 hardy Mayfair seniors enjoyed weekly walks with OUTREACH Mobility Management Center staff. As part of OUTREACH's active transportation activities, these walks are designed to encourage walking as both exercise and as a healthy mobility option for older adults. In addition to the weekly walks, OUTREACH staff worked with Mayfair seniors to identify walking hazards in the neighborhood surrounding the Mayfair Community Center as well as encouraged seniors to consider the combination of walking and public transit as a means of low-cost travel.

While the seniors will now be leading the walking program at Mayfair, you can join the OUTREACH Mobility Management Center staff Wednesday mornings at the Southside Senior Center for our *Senior Walk* @ *Southside*.
