**SUBJECT:** Hillview Community Center Project - Program Review

### **BACKGROUND**

The City of Los Altos is looking into the options available to make improvements and/or replace the Hillview Community Center facility. The portion of the facility being considered for this discussion is the Hillview Community Center building, which is comprised of two large multi-purpose rooms and 17 smaller activity/meeting rooms.

At the June 18 City Council Retreat, staff was charged with developing a new plan for the renovation/replacement of the Hillview Community Center. Staff is currently taking steps toward accomplishing this over the course of the next year.

### **DISCUSSION**

Staff is working with the chosen architect to fulfill the scope of work to identify models for a new Community Center that would fall within the Council designated \$20M amount for the project. As part of the first step in this process, the Parks and Recreation and Senior Commissions were tasked with evaluating and prioritizing the programing and usage of the Hillview Community Center.

The Senior Commission will create a prioritized list of programs/room types for the proposed Hillview Community Center. This new list will be provided to the architect working on the first phase of this project within the next two weeks.
