2. Fiscal Year 2020/21 Work Plan Update

Work Plan prepared for the Joint City Council Meeting scheduled for May 4, 2021. Work assignments may change with the Senior Commission reorganization.

Action: Liaison Matheson to schedule one more Work Plan subcommittee meeting before the May 4th Joint City Council Meeting.

Goal 1, Project 1: Vision to expand use of new Community Center is on hiatus and will reinstate when Covid-19 conditions allow.

Project 2: On going, shift and change programs on Spotlight but good attendance on virtual events. Greentown Lunch and Foreign Affairs class have over 40 attendees. Channel 15 growing and targeting more fitness (yoga, tai chi) as well as ukulele and French cooking programs.

Goal 2, Project 1: On hold, the reopening of Grant Park and new Community Center pending. Ian Geatz reaching out to gather input from the Community to better organize and communicate schedules.

Project 2: June/July opening of Community Center is still TBD. Outdoor amenities and classes may be first phase (bocce ball and playgrounds). Grant Park reopening may require a separate start schedule, but most programs are all indoors.

Goal 3, Projects 1,2,3: Transportation reimbursement (use still at zero) and on hold.

Action: Liaison Matheson to look into expanding and promoting transportation to include vaccination and testing. Flexibility for out of area location sites. Pending approval. Chair O'Reilly to follow up with Liaison Matheson and Cheri Anderson.

Goal 4, Project 1: Regarding Health and Safety, Commissioner Buchholz wants to encourage Seniors getting vaccinated.

Action: Mayor Fligor would like to get County report on percentage of Los Altos Seniors vaccinated and would like to review Buchholz's vaccination research paper.

Goal 5, Project 1: On hold TBD. Metrics to measure intension unclear for compliance

Goal 6, To be deleted. Online resource guide needs to be redone, revisited and referred to the County's "Source Wise" guide beyond the Los Altos Borders.
