The YAC Attack Conference is a biennial teen leadership conference that focuses on empowering youth/teens to promote change by 1) encouraging greater involvement within their local municipal government, 2) developing positive youth and teen special events and programs in their community, and 3) learning about youth and teen-specific health and wellness issues.
